.tif files

The .tif files are the parts of the seismic cube. These have been scanned at 2 resolutions, 300 dpi and 600 dpi, as reflected in the labels; use either set. The side and interior sections all have a front and back, labeled with an “f” or “b” in the file name. The front and back files are opposite sides of a single section. The top and bottom are only one sided.
