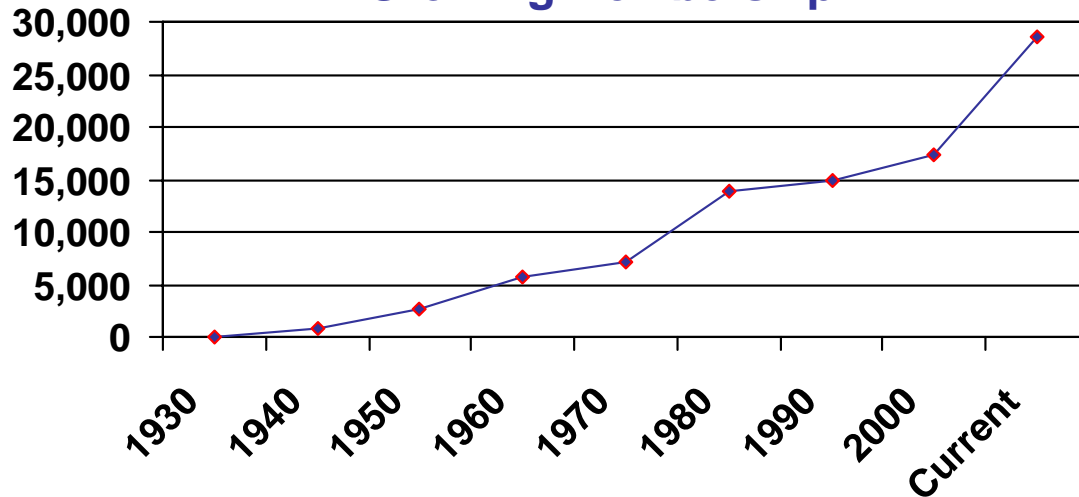

With more than 25,000 members worldwide (130 countries), the Society is committed to the dissemination of geophysical knowledge among its members, with continuously improving professional practice as its goal.

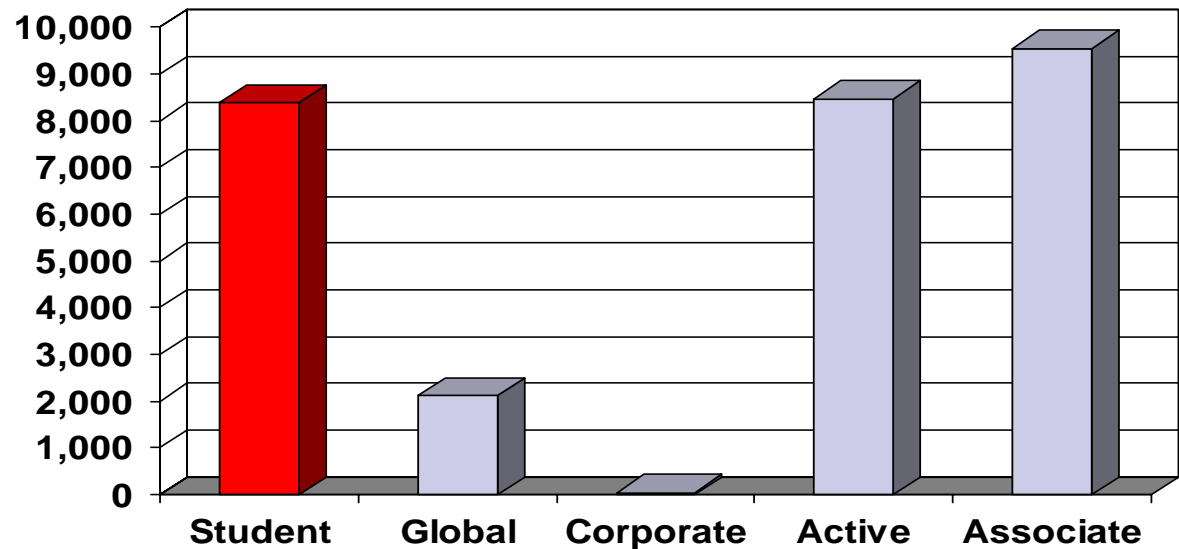

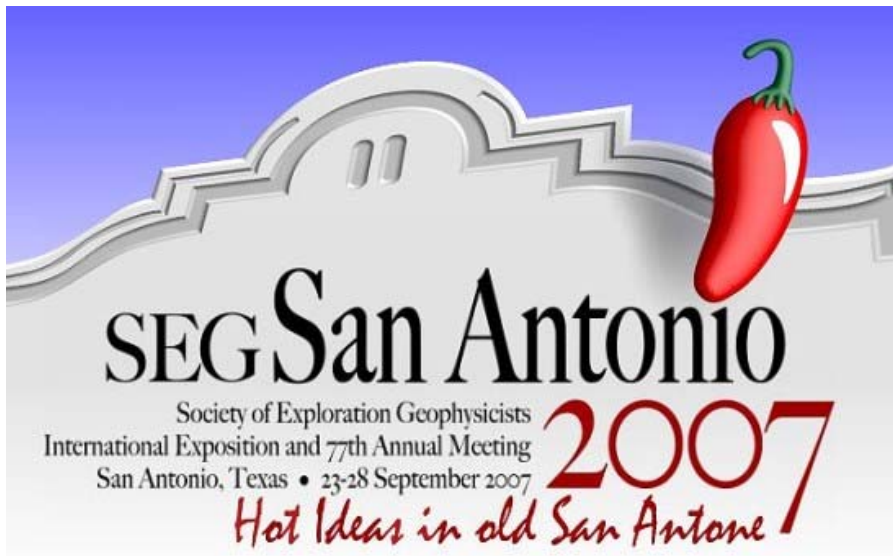

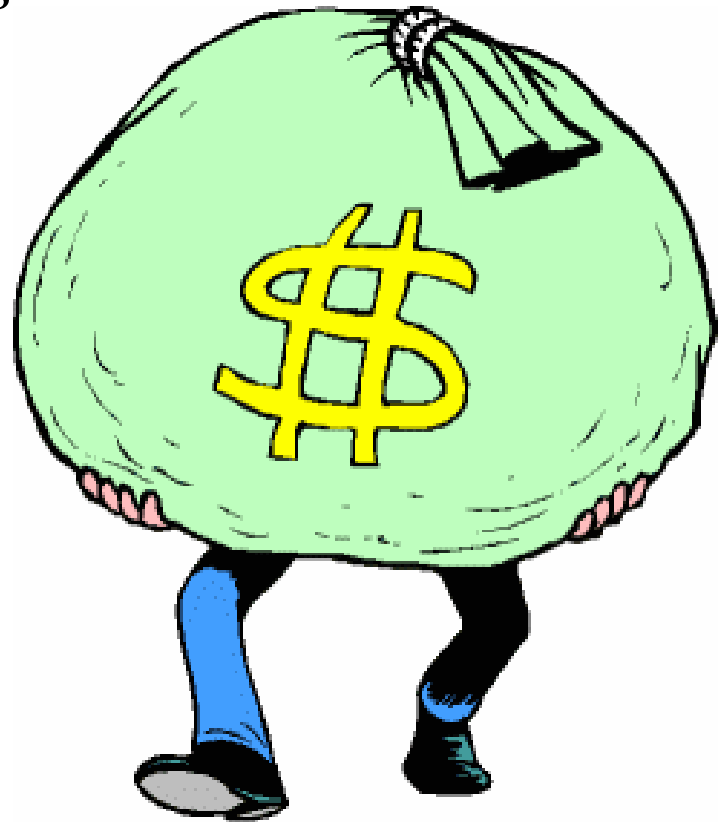
