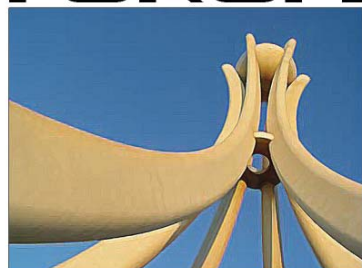

Reservoir Characterization and Monitoring in Carbonates

Application Deadline: 9 December 2008

By far the largest and most extensive petroleum reservoirs worldwide exist in carbonate reservoirs, chiefly located in the Middle East. As these reservoirs mature it becomes imperative that we apply advanced geophysical and reservoir engineering technology to evaluate, monitor and ultimately manage these important resources.

In 2009 we will turn the attention of the D and P Forum series to carbonate reservoirs. The 5 day meeting in Bahrain will examine the geological and geophysical characteristics and the role of geophysics in characterizing and managing carbonate reservoirs. Included in the program are:

- Geological framework and heterogeneity,
- Rock physics and formation evaluation,
- Seismic characteristics, including 3D and 4D and passive seismics,
- Electrical and potential methods in carbonates
- Fracture characterization and
- Reservoir simulation and modeling.

We welcome your participation in this forum. Be prepared for a lively meeting full of discussion and new ideas.

Abstracts: There are no formal proceedings from the Forum. In an effort to encourage candor, presentations are made in an "off-the-record" spirit. However, participants are encouraged to distribute expanded abstracts of their own presentations.

Meeting Format: The meeting will comprise a mixture of poster and oral presentations. Posters will be displayed all week to allow opportunity for focused discussion among small groups. As in previous years, the poster sessions start with a short introduction using no more than two slides. Delegates will have the opportunity to attend all posters during formal sessions. Oral presentations will complement the poster sessions and will include keynote speakers. Experience of previous D&P Forums is that discussion sessions are lively and wide-ranging; the proportion of delegates that actively participate is always high.

- Friday, 10 April — Registration and Ice Breaker
- Saturday, 11 April through Wednesday, 15 April — Technical Sessions and Poster Sessions
- Tuesday, 14 April — Group Dinner

Due Dates: Applications can be mailed, emailed, or faxed to Canaan Rice by Wednesday, 9 December 2008, 5pm CST. A copy of the application can be found on the SEG Web site at <http://seg.org/meetings/dpforum>.

Acceptance: Direct participation of all Forum attendees is mandatory. Participation may be through poster, oral presentation or discussion contributions. Neither oral nor poster presentations is a requirement in order to be accepted for registration. If the number of applicants exceeds the capacity of the conference facilities, then preference will be given to presenters.

Student Registration: Students are encouraged to submit papers. Students chosen to present will receive a discounted registration rate. This rate will be established prior to all registration deadlines and will be included with acceptance letters.

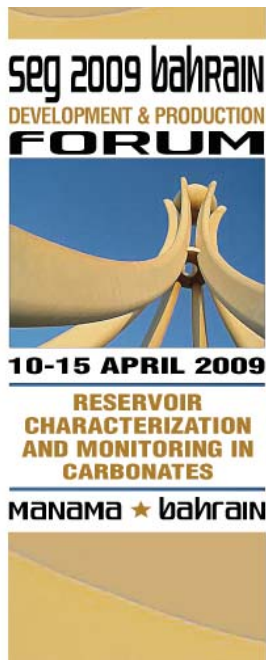
